Protocols for Safe and Healthy Schools 2021-2022

COVID-19 Intervention Plan

Due to an increase in COVID-19 numbers, the potential for future increases, and out of concern for the health and safety of our students, staff, and community, the following intervention plan has been added to the [Protocols for Safe and Healthy Schools](#) guidelines.

This plan includes information regarding updated decision points for masks, potential closures, extra-curricular activities, and teacher responsibilities. Any steps outlined in this Intervention Plan will function along with the existing Protocols for Safe and Healthy Schools mitigation practices already in place.

Face Coverings/Masks:

1. At any time, if 25 or more students test positive for COVID-19, all students (grades 2-12), staff, and any visitors on campuses will be required to wear a [mask/face covering](#).
2. Masks will then be required until active positive COVID-19 cases have fallen below 15 for five consecutive days and a minimum of 10 school days have passed.
3. During the 10 days, if at any time COVID-19 positive cases rise above 25 again, the ten days will start over. The updated timeline will be communicated to all students, staff, and families.

Extra-Curricular Events and Activities:

1. The leadership team will make decisions regarding masks for spectators and/or student participation in extra-curricular events

Potential Closure Decision Points: Although SCISD anticipates continuing with in-person instruction with the use of masking and other mitigation protocols, there could be situations where the leadership team will have to make decisions for campus or district closure such as in the situations listed below.

1. High student numbers of positive COVID-19 cases, and/or evidence of rapid transmission of the virus.
2. High teacher positive COVID-19 cases such that adjustments cannot be made to keep students safe and continue to provide effective instruction.

**In the event of a campus closure, teachers will continue to work on campus.*

***In the event of a district closure, teachers will not be required to work as extra calendar minutes will be used to account for the closure.*
